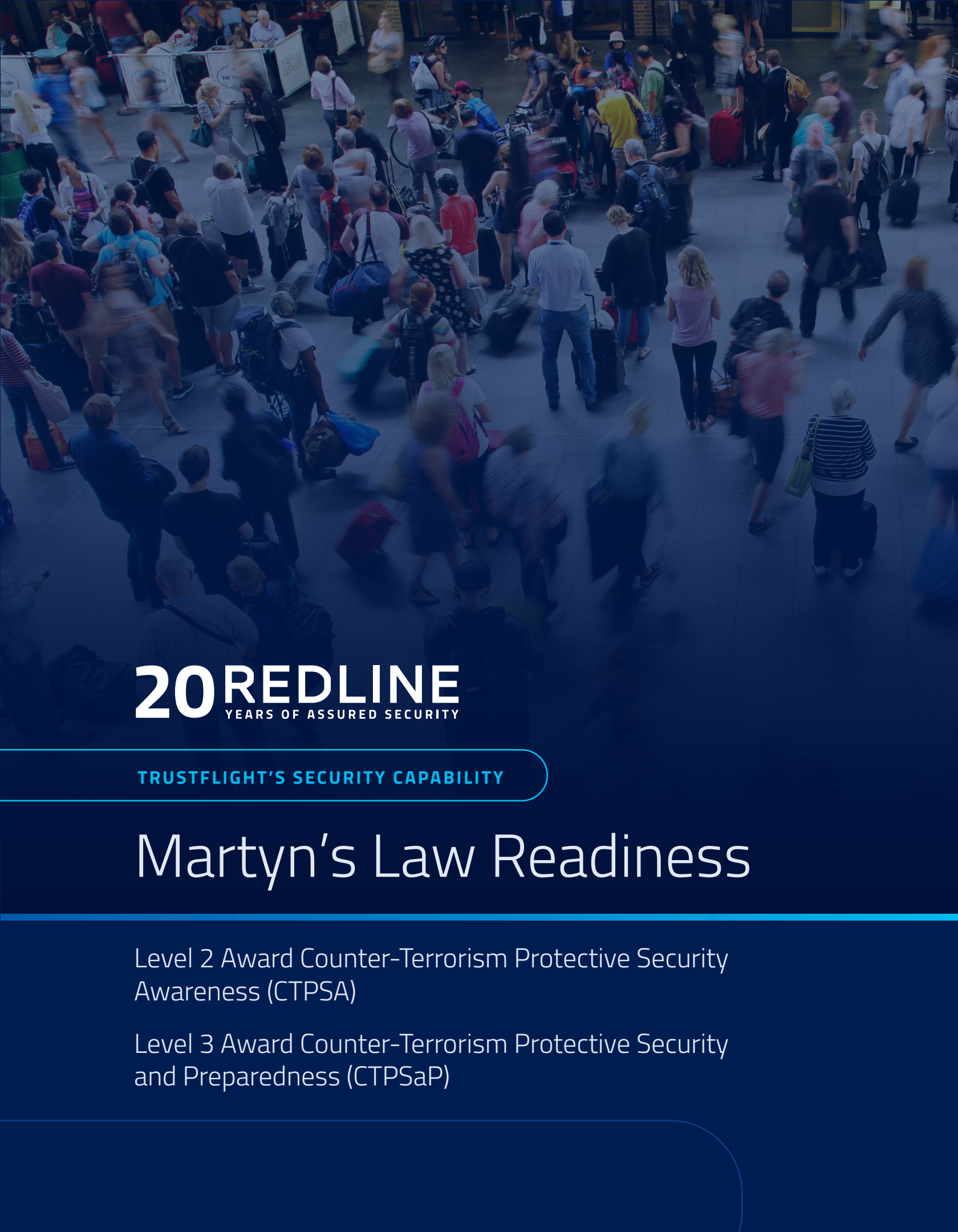

Hostile reconnaissance, suspicious behaviour, See-Check-Notify (SCaN), escalation.

04

Understand Immediate Response Principles

Evacuation/invacuation/ lockdown, HOT/4Cs, CBRN response, trauma first aid (PACT).
